Tenure of Office

- Serve on at least one Board Committee at the request of the President.
- Represent the best interests of the organization on all issues raised in Board meetings, based on careful analysis of agendas and supporting material.
- Know and uphold the regulations, policies, and procedures of the organization

Application Format

All candidates must submit the information outlined below, which will constitute their application:

- Name, home address, phone and e-mail address
- Current position
- Career highlights and history (a summary of significant activities and positions held)
- Education
- AAGT participation (include conventions attended, presentations, committee work) and accomplishments
- Significant leadership activities
- Candidates are requested to provide a minimum of two references
- Statement of Candidacy (150 words maximum for inclusion on ballot). The BOD Selection Committee reserves the right to edit any Statement of Candidacy to meet space requirements on the ballot.

Submission
